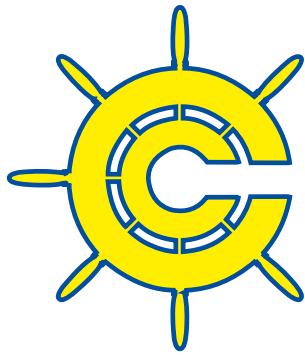

Couples Cruise 2011 Guidelines

Please help us ensure everyone has the best possible time by abiding by all of our (and RCCL's) conduct rules and by looking out for fellow Couples Cruise attendees. Your actions represent our event and will go a long way toward our acceptance in this community.

The Radiance of the Seas security staff is very tolerant but we do not need to test their tolerance. Keep your parties private and behind closed doors. Please dress properly while walking around the ship.

The ship reserves the right to put passengers off the ship, at any port, who will not follow their rules of conduct. If this happens, you will not get a refund and you will have to make your own way home from the port. Plus, you'll look really silly and your friends will laugh at you as we sail away.

Please read and adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Respect: "No means No!" Anyone that doesn't understand this or is making unwanted advances could be subject to expulsion from the ship at the next port, without a refund.

2. Nudity Rules: Nudity is only allowed on the pool decks (11, 12, 13), and all hallways leading to your cabin. Topless is permitted in the Starquest Disco (deck 13). Please note that you cannot go Nude in any elevator; you must be covered. No nudity is allowed in the restaurants, casino, shops, atrium, lounges, or other public places not mentioned above. Please sit on a towel at all times if nude, it's just common courtesy. In going to the Playcate's "Pleasure Chamber" (Colony Club), please wear a robe or cover up. No nudity in port, unless specifically announced.

3. Sexual Activity Rules: Feel free to get to know one another on the dance floor, exchange contact info, or meet afterwards in your cabin; but no sexual activity is permitted in the dances, pool deck, lobby or any public place. There is a time and a place for everything; sexual activity can only take place in your private cabins or in a designated private hospitality area.

Under no circumstances can you approach any of the shipboard staff for any sexual reason. They are not permitted in your cabin or they will lose their jobs. This rule is extremely important and we know that you would not want to be escorted off the ship at the next port. Naturally, there would be no refund.

4. Prostituting: Passengers are not permitted to pay nor accept payment to engage in any form of entertainment or sexual activity.

5. No Drugs: This is simple- "Just Say No" Anyone breaking this rule will be banned from any of our future events and cruises forever, again- no refund. Do not buy drugs in ports, you will be arrested. If you try to bring drugs back onto the ship, you will be arrested.

6. Camera Policy: Photos of other passengers without permission is not allowed. If you are seen taking photos of groups of people without their permission, your camera can be taken by security to be reviewed. Inappropriate photos will be deleted at the discretion of the security supervisor. Any photos taken on board the ship are for personal use only. Photos from this charter cruise cannot be published, printed, made public on the internet, YouTube or used for any other purpose without written approval from Couples Cruise. Note: NO photography allowed in the Colony Club (play area) at all!

7. You Must Listen to the Ship's Security & our Couple Cruise Staff: If someone says you are acting or dressed inappropriately, you probably are. Please respect the ship's security, they are here to protect you and our attendees. Anyone not adhering to our or the ship's conduct policies can be put off the ship at the next port.

8. Intoxication: If you become intoxicated and disruptive, you will be escorted to your cabin.

9. Protect Yourself: It is your responsibility to act responsibly when it comes to personal protection.

10. Smoking: Smoking is permitted only in designated areas of the ship. No smoking is permitted in any cabin. Smoking is permitted on your balcony and other designated areas throughout the ship. Please note that RCCL will impose a

Dining Tips

1. Get there early

The main dining room opens at 6:30 pm and every table on both levels will be empty and ready for hot bodies. You may have to stand in a line to get in, but once you do, you will get to eat 1st and you will be done 1st and ready to have some fun and party the night away.

Added Bonus: If you eat early, you will be done in time to see the main production or comedy show in the main theater. The shows are great and well worth checking out.

2. Don't try to have everyone you know at one table

Last cruise, people saw friends in line or invited them to join them and a party of four became tables of eight and then twelve and then 20!

It is extremely hard for the wait staff to "put tables together" in the main dining room. They do have tables that will seat twelve, so please try to keep your parties to twelve or below.

3. Sit with someone new each night

The best part about open seating is that you can sit with different people every night. I know you probably have friends from back home on board, but why not make some new friends.

Try walking in and randomly being seated with strangers. If you don't hit it off, it's not like you have to sit by them the next night.

4. Be Patient

Our 1st tip was to get there early, to make sure you have a seat, if you show up around 8:30 pm, all of the tables just might be full and you might have to wait a few minutes before a table comes open.

Use this time wisely, have someone grab a drink in the Caliente Centrum Bar, say "Hi!" to a stranger, be patient and don't be a rush. After all, the night is still young on Couples Cruise.

Playcate Pleasure Chamber Tips

1. Wear appropriate clothing

In order to get into the play area (in the Colony Club), you can't wear street clothes. You must be in a robe, boxers, lingerie, a towel, etc...

Why? Because we've been doing this for a long time and we found out years ago, that if people were fully dressed in street clothes, the "play area" became a social area with lots of talking, socializing, etc... If people were dressed down, it became a real "play area".

On the last cruise, we got a little bit of a push back from a few passengers that didn't want to change, but once they did, they were apologizing and fully understood why we implemented this rule. You cannot leave clothes at the door, you must leave them in your cabin or bring them with you.

2. Be prepared

Make sure you leave your wallet, fancy watch and your personal items in your cabin and bring a small bag with personal protection, lubricant, toys, etc...

3. Clean up after yourself

We don't go to your house and throw used personal protection items on your floor and we'd appreciate it if you don't do it on ours. Use the trash can people! Don't be a "Condom Creep!"

4. Couples in, Couples Out

This is a Couples Cruise, not a "I'm gonna cruise around while my partner is asleep in the cabin" cruise. Bring your partner to the play area and when they are ready to head out, go with them.

5. Be respectful and report any issues quickly

If you see someone causing problems, simply come to the door and let one of our staff members know about the situation. Our worse fear is to hear about it the next morning when we can't do anything about it.

6. Use your "Inside Voice"

People are trying to have some serious fun. If you are not actively playing, keep it down or head out to the Dream Pleasure Tours Schooner Bar to socialize.

3. 5th Street

2. Where is sexual activity permitted?

Sexual activity is only allowed in your stateroom or in the private playroom located on the 6th Deck, in Playcate's "Pleasure Chamber" (Colony Club).

We believe strongly that there is a time and place for having fun and there is a time and place for sexual activity. Even though you might be an exhibitionist, that doesn't mean that other people want to see you having sex in the jacuzzi. O.K., I'm not even going there...

3. Don't mess with the Ship's Staff

Another important thing I must point out: there are over 2,100 people on board to flirt with, get to know and have fun with, so get to know them and leave the RCCL staff alone. I know there are some people out there that like the challenge of corrupting "vanillas" and having fun with someone their not supposed to.

I know some people like the challenge of corrupting "vanillas", but save it for home. I know most of the RCL staff is hot, I get it, but they will get fired if they get caught having fun with you. And you will get kicked off the ship. I know you don't want either of those things to happen.

There are plenty of fish in the sea, please leave the ship's staff alone. O.K., now back to the fun stuff.

Photography

This subject needs its own full article, so I thought I should include it here. Here is the most important single rule you need to know about taking pictures: Don't take pictures of people without their permission. Ever. Period. Got it?

Some cruises, resorts & conventions have strict "No Camera" rules and I always see cameras at them. Eventually, someone gets pissed and I've seen fights break out and cameras wrestled over and security get involved... needless to say, the "No Camera" rules never work.

So, we are instituting a rule that allows people to use cameras, but only to take photos of themselves, not general pictures of the cruise itself.

If you see anyone taking pictures of you, please let us know ASAP and we will have the picture(s) deleted. Anyone repeatedly breaking this rule will have their camera confiscated until the end of the cruise.

1: Check your background before shooting

If you want to take a picture of you and your friends having a great time on the Couples Cruise, then back up against the bar, the DJ booth, the side of the ship or a wall, but make sure you aren't including other guests in the background.

2: Use the ship's photo services

Every night, the ship's photographers will set up elaborate back drops with very professional flash and camera set ups that will get you some great, quality pictures.

Jump in line and take a couple of shots each night, it doesn't cost anything to take the photo, only to buy them if they turn out great. If you take 12 different shots and you only like 4, just pay for the 4 and the ship will get rid of the rest.

3: Use these photos in your online profiles

Most of you belong to one (if not many) online lifestyle communities (ie: Lifestyle Lounge, SwingLifestyle, SDC, Couples Touch, LoveVooDoo.com, etc...). One of the biggest problems with these sites is getting good photos to use for your profile. Problem solved.

Music

Music is the single hardest thing for any lifestyle promoter when putting on an event. Luckily for you, there are lots of great choices of music all around the ship. If you don't like the music where you are, go someplace else, chances are, they will be playing something you like.

If you can't find any music to your liking, suggest something, our DJ's strive to play a wide variety of music, but they won't have everything and to be honest, some things just shouldn't be played (no Chicken Dance this week!).

I had a girl come up to me once, after having a few cocktails, and said: "This music Sucks!" To which I replied, "What would you like to hear?", "Anything but this crap!" she shouted. We were off to a great start.

Here is a sampling of what you can expect from our different venues, but be sure to check out the Daily Compass, because we may change things up a little every once in a while:

Main Pool Deck

During the day, we will play fun pool party music at a moderate level with only a couple of breaks (during the sea days) for a contest or two.

At night, we are going to pump up the music, turn on the light show and turn this space into a Vegas style nightclub. We will start off with Top 40, then progress to Mash-up, then House and more electronic club music.



Warning: this is where it gets loud and full of energy, if it is too loud for you, you might want to check out another venue or head up to the 12th deck for a great view and a little quieter atmosphere.

Caliente Centrum

During the day, you can enjoy classical strings, piano or guitar and then later on, full bands playing ballroom, then top 40 and dance music, making this area a great place to dance to live bands at a lower volume level than the Disco or Pool Deck Parties.

Dream Pleasure Tours Lounge (Schooner Bar)

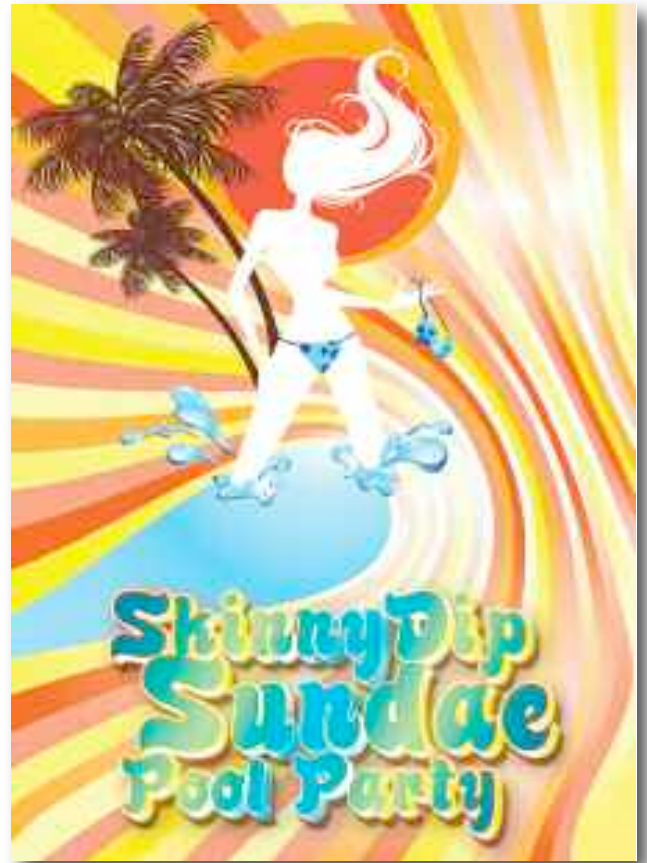

Colette goes Caribbean

The Beginning

Tess & I have been members of Colette since it opened in 2002. At the time, we had an off-premise club about an hour from Colette, but we were only open on Fri & Sat and we would often head down to Colette on the weekdays to get away from work and have some fun.

Before Colette even opened, the owners contacted us and we met for lunch. We talked about each of our business plans and where we expected to be in 10 years. There is no way either of us had expected ourselves to be where we are today, but we are both very happy with the outcome.

Eventually, we closed our Off-Premise club to concentrate on our larger events and conventions and that is what led us here, to the Couples Cruise, Naughty in N'awlins, Couples Fest in Key West and LLive in Las Vegas. We've hosted several other national conventions and are in the planning stages for other great events as well. Throughout the years, we always kept going back to Colette, as it provided us with a local place to meet couples and not have to work for a change.

When Katrina swept through New Orleans in 2005, it took with it all of the furniture at Colette and caused a lot of damage on the ground floor. After replacing much of the sheetrock and other renovations, Colette was open again, but furniture-less and a little stark.

At first, I loaned them some of the convention furniture we had used for a past events, but this wasn't a permanent solution, just a temporary fix so people have a place to sit down.

About a year later, I was visiting the owner (John Melfi) at the club and I mentioned that it was time to upgrade the furnishings and the decor and mentioned that I might be able to help. That night, a partnership was born.

We had several meetings after that and just before our Naughty in N'awlins convention in 2009, we unveiled a "New Colette", with a complete make over. We brought in a designer/seamstress (Becky) from Las Vegas who works with us on our conventions and she and I spent two solid weeks (with a lot of help from friends, volunteers and employees) to complete the re-decorating.

Each year, we start our New Orleans convention with a party at Colette. Many of our attendees were impressed with the new look. Rich, red velvet drapes covered the

entire length of the club, sexy white curved couches lined the dancefloor, modern black sectional sofas tripled the seating room and large, oversized (5' tall!) black & white photographs showcased the high ceilings.

We also brought lots of accessories like candles, statues, pillows, trays and other things to tie everything together. All of a sudden, Colette felt brand new again and so was the Colette experience.



We took what we did at our conventions and we applied it to a brick & mortar club and the results were great. Our goal at our conventions were always to make the place look more than just a "party suite" or a regular hotel room. Our goal at our conventions is to transform ordinary hotel space into extraordinary play areas where ladies would feel sexy and inspired to expand their boundaries and explore their fantasies. We have done the same on this cruise.

Colette is that place 52 weeks of the year. It wasn't someplace we had to quickly erect in a couple of hours and then tear down a couple of days later, this installation became a home for it's local couples and a sanctuary for those visiting from afar. It was exactly as we had dreamed of and with the help of John and our team, it was more in line with his dreams too.

Caribe

Tess and I travel quite a bit and in the fall of 2009 we were invited to a Lifestyle Leadership Conference in the Dominican Republic at Caliente Caribe. We had been wanting to visit this property for some time and this looked like a great time of the year for us to check it out.

We met other club owners as well as convention planners, website owners and travel agents. It was an awesome week, not only to be able to enjoy the resort (which we did!), but it was great to be able to hang out with so many of our peers.

The resort far exceeded our expectations. The photos we saw didn't do the resort justice as it was one of the most beautiful properties we have ever set foot on. We couldn't get over how beautiful (and private) this bay on the north shore of the DR was and we knew that this would be the beginning of many visits for us.

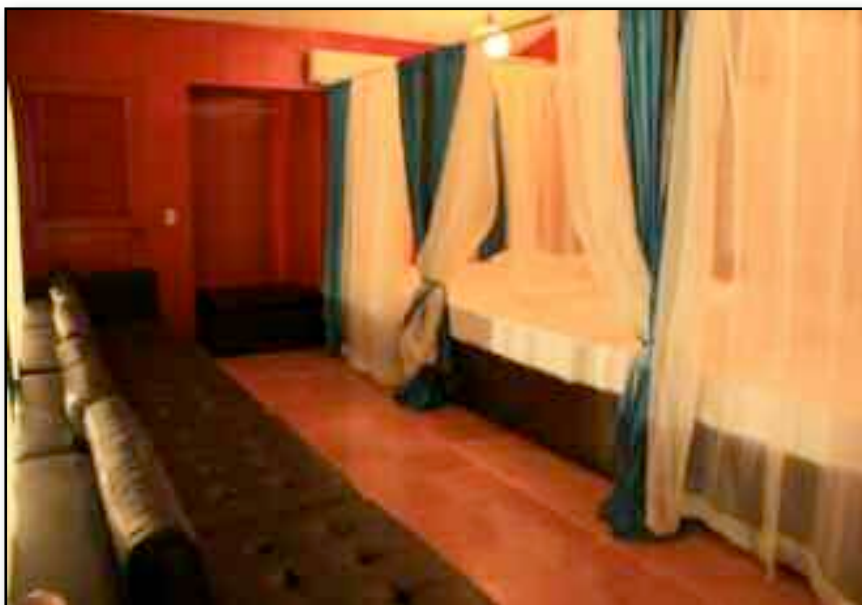


