Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: What are the theme nights?

A: Some of the theme nights are available on our website, but our Entertainment director is working hard on finalizing the list and locations for you. As soon as he has, we will be sending out a detailed list.

Q: Where is nudity allowed? A: The only areas where full nudity can take place are in the play rooms and by the pools (while out to sea only). Partial nudity is allowed inside of the theme parties. Outside of that, all genitals (including, but not limited to bare bottoms) must be covered.

Q: Will there be a formal night?

A: Yes. It is one of the theme nights and you will be able to be as sexy as you want to be while sticking with the theme.

Q: Do you have to wear a bathing suite while in port?

A: Yes. This is a very strict rule that will be enforced.

Q: When will our documents be here?

A: You will receive your e-tickets approximately three weeks before the cruise. You will be required to print them and bring them to the ship with you.

Q: How do we book shore excursions?

A: You can pre-book all of the lifestyle excursions* now, by calling 866-699-9695. The tickets will be in your cabin waiting for you when you board the ship. Carnival will also be offering their regular excursions which you will be able to pre-book on Carnival's website when you get your booking numbers. These will arrive with your tickets approximately three weeks before the cruise.

*Snorkeling at Paya Bay is already sold out. Beach Break at Paya Bay is still available.

Q: Can we book lifestyle excursions while on board the ship? A: Yes. All lifestyle excursions can be booked after April 20th or on board, while supplies last. There will be a \$10 per ticket fee for late ticket sales.

Q: Can we still book a room at Caliente or the Hilton?

A: No, both hotels are completely sold out.

Q: Are the presale activities clothing optional?

A: All of the presale activities are clothing optional except IMOS and Senior Frogs.

Q: Where is my YOLO Confirmation/Invoice number?

A: This is on the invoice that you have received. If you did not receive one, please contact your travel agent immediately.

Q: Why can't I find my cabin on Carnival's website?

A: After we started selling cabins for YOLO, Carnival relabeled their cabin categories. To see your correct cabin category, please visit <http://www.yolocruises.com/>

Q: Can I bring alcohol on board?

A: No hard liquor is allowed on board and will be confiscated by customs or the ships officers at embarkation and at each port. One bottle of wine or champagne per person is permitted. These bottles will be assessed a \$10 corkage fee.

Q: Is there a plan that can be purchased which will allow for unlimited alcohol?

A: Absolutely not.

Q: Can I purchase alcohol at the gift shop and take it back to my room?

A: No. All alcohol purchased on board will be stored and distributed only on the last night of the cruise.

Q: Can I bring handcuffs?

A: Absolutely not. None of any kind, including but not limited to plastic or furry handcuffs.

Q: I thought that the pool was nude all the time. What gives?

A: The pool is nude at all times EXCEPT when the ship is docked in port. The ship is only docked in port in Cozumel and Roatan.

Q: What dining time am I assigned?

A: You are not assigned a dining time. All dining rooms have open seating for all meals.

Q: Will the ship still sail if we do not reach a certain number of passengers?

A: It most certainly will. Yolo has so much faith in our product that we purchased the ship and paid IN FULL before the first cabin was ever sold.

Q: How much of the ship is sold right now?

A: We will be sailing at close to capacity if not at capacity, but specific numbers are not available. Please disregard any rumors you hear that state otherwise.

Q: Is there any availability at Caliente?

A: No, the resort is completely sold out.
