### Monster Jeep to Oceanside Mayan Ruins

In a Monster Jeep, you have the opportunity to live your Jurassic Park dreams—exploring parts of the island very few people have ever had the chance to see. On a path north—once traveled by the Mayans and now accessible only by 4x4 vehicle—you'll make your way toward oceanfront Mayan ruins for a beachside lunch to wrap up the expedition.



### Cozumel 3 Reef Snorkel by Boat

Coral reef formations are all individual and uniquely different—much like how your mom would describe you. But this time, it's true (kidding—you're amazing). From our ship's pier, cruise out into the turquoise waters en route to 3 distinct reef locations for 3 very different snorkeling experiences. Between snorkeling among the colorful coral reef formations and exotic fish of each location, you'll have time to take in the views from the leisurely boat ride to each spot.



### Cooking Lesson and Mezcal Tasting in a Tulum Home

With a group of no more than 12 people, it's an intimate introduction to local tradition and food. In combination with a mezcal tasting, the experience culminates in a sit-down dinner to share and celebrate in your creations. Afterwards, you'll have time to explore Playa del Carmen before boarding the ship.



### Mexican Cuisine Workshop and Tasting

In this unique, hands-on Mexican meal preparation workshop—a local chef will unveil the secrets to cooking a three-course menu at a fully-equipped workstation. While you and the chef are preparing your meal, feel free to sip some of the Mexican wine as you work. ### The Amazing Secret River: Nature's Crystal Museum

After a short instructional driving course—vroom vroom—it's time to hit the dirt roads in an ATV and explore Cozumel's jungle. Once you've made your way to the Caribbean Sea, you'll have the opportunity to maximize your speeding style by driving a speedboat past deserted beaches and lagoons. Once your need for speed has been properly satiated, jump in the coral reef-rich waters with a snorkel and mask, and explore the colorful world beneath the surface.

### Cozumel Snuba Diving Adventure

Snuba diving, like snorkeling, doesn't require the use of an air tank to breathe while swimming underwater. Instead, the air tank is connected to a small raft that sits on the water above you. After a short introduction, you'll visit the Cozumel Reef Restoration project—where several environmental groups have teamed up to create breathtaking coral gardens. After the 25-min dive, you can utilize snorkel equipment, or hit up the nearby restaurant and bar serving local food and drinks.



### Scuba Diving for Newbies in Cozumel

This tour has been designed for non-certified scuba divers who want to learn in delicate waters. After receiving instructions from a PADI-instructor, you'll put on the gear (with help, of course) and get directly in the water from the beach. Once you've spent a few minutes in waist-deep water getting used to breathing underwater, you'll head out with the guide to explore Cozumel's famous coral formations and curious tropical fish.



### Mayan City of Ek' Balam and Cenote Dip

Asleep for many centuries, Ek' Balam, "The Black Jaguar," is awakening before the eyes of the world. The vast dimensions of the structures, highly-decorated facades and walls surrounding the main plaza are the highlights of this archeological site. After the tour, take a dip in the crystalline water of an underground cenote—or "natural well." Submerge in this mystical pool as the blues and greens dance with the reflecting rays atop the water before heading back to the pier.



### Chichén Itzá and Sacred Cenote Tour

The tour begins at Chichén Itzá—one of the largest Mayan cities and now considered one of the Seven New Wonders of the World. As you wander through, you can feel the history and culture brimming from the sacred site. With 365 steps, the great Mayan astronomers created the largest calendar oriented to mark solstices and equinoxes in the Temple of Kukulcan. Afterwards, swim in a cenote—a sacred freshwater pool that the Maya believed represented the entrance to the underworld.



### Clear Kayak, Snorkel and Beach Day

From atop your completely transparent kayak, Sailors will have the ability to see everything above & below the water as you glide across the sea. And for a different angle, grab a mask and fins and snorkel down under the surface and start looking for a colorful school of fish to join. Afterwards, head back up to the beach facilities to soak up the sun, swim in the pool, or relax under the shade of an umbrella.



### Cozumel Coral Reef Restoration

At Cozumel's only Reef Restoration program, experts provide you with an introduction to coral reproduction and restoration concepts—including an up-close look at coral spawning at the shoreside aquarium. Afterwards, guides will take you on a snorkel tour of the coral gardens, followed by downtime at a bar at the beach with local food and drinks. Proceeds from your participation support the Coral Farms program, allowing the program to continue their efforts to replenish reefs and educate others.



### Cozumel's Caribbean Bar Crawl

On this crawl, you'll explore the downtown area of the island while visiting the "must-see" bars—where a complimentary welcome drink and friendly staff will be waiting for you. Some spots are: El Palomar—a Caribbean-style house with some of the best drinks on the island; Thirsty Cougar—located on the main boulevard, popular for both locals and tourists; and Cervceria Punta Sur—an authentic local bar where they make their own beer.



### To a Tee: Cozumel Country Club Golf

Cozumel Country Club is an 18-hole, par 72 championship golf course built around Cozumel's native trees, mangroves, marshlands and tropical rainforest. The course totals 6,816 yards from the back tees, and is (also) home to blue crabs, iguanas, crocodiles, raccoons, a multitude of bird species and other wildlife. Don't be mad if the iguanas are a better shot than you—they get more practice.



### Cozumel Shore Snorkeling for Newbies

This tour of the Villa Blanca Reef is designed to give even the most novice snorkeler a rich underwater experience. Your PADI-certified dive guides will help you with your gear and teach you everything you need to know. Once you're ready, you'll be accompanied on a guided tour of the breathtaking views of coral formations and colorful tropical fish, in depths varying from 3 to 20 feet. Afterwards, you'll have time to visit the restaurant and bar on location serving local food and drinks.

### Muyil Maya Site and Secret River

On this tour, you'll visit the Muyil Ruins—also known as Chunyaxché —a UNESCO World Heritage site located on the edge of a lagoon in the Sian Ka'an Biosphere preserve. It was a major maritime trading port with close ties to the large nearby site of Coba. Afterwards, head to an embarking pier—where your captain will take you along the old Maya trading channels, visit a small Maya ruin on the way and swim in pristine, crystal-clear waters before heading back to Playa del Carmen.



### Cozumel's Punta Sur Park Exploration

Punta Sur is a 247-acre ecological park that covers the reefs, beaches, lagoons and forest of the surrounding area. From peak croc-watching opportunities at the crocodile watch tower to climbing the iconic Celarain lighthouse for a stunning view from the nautical museum—you'll spend the latter part of the tour driving through the dense jungle in search of secluded beaches. Once there, dip your toes in the tranquil waters and relax with a locally made and well-earned adult beverage.



### Margarita and Chocolate Mixology

At the Mayan Cacao Company, unearth the history of chocolate and learn how it became such a central role in Mayan social and religious life. See the manufacturing process first-hand, participate in a demonstration and sample delicious artisanal chocolate. Walk into the workshop ready to create a chocolate margarita from scratch. Oh, and then drink it. Just like that, you've found your new go-to drink.



### Mayan Ruins of Tulum and Kaan Luum Lagoon

On this tour, you'll navigate the remains of the ancient ruins of Tulum—like the pyramid temple of El Castillo, the Temple of the Frescoes and the Templo Dios del Viento (God of the Winds Temple). After the ruins, head to the exotic and often overlooked Kaan Luum lagoon for a scenic and leisurely swim. Hidden in the Mayan jungle, Kaan Luum has a deep cenote in the center, which causes the rims of the lagoon to be a totally different, seafoam-green color from the center.



### Mayan Bee Sanctuary and Senses Tour

The first stop on this colorful tour is the Mayan Bee Sanctuary—where you'll learn the significance of the sacred stingless Melipona Bees and the cenotes they live near. Explore the cenotes as the bees interact in their natural space while you learn about the benefits of the bees' golden liquid (and maybe even have a small tasting). Your second stop will be at a small bar, where you'll sip a cocktail by the sea before moving on to your last stop, an extraordinary Spice Market.



### Tequila and Chocolate Tasting Tour

On this tour, you'll experience Mexico's most famous flavors while learning the best ways to prepare and enjoy them. Starting with chocolate, your tour begins with a dipping experience as you learn to grind, mix and create your own chocolate bar from cocoa beans while learning about their regional origins. Moving on to Tequila at the Jose Cuervo facility, you'll learn the history of all of the tequilas produced, and how to sip, savor and create the perfect margarita. You'll finish with an open-air lunch of local food while witnessing an unbelievable Pananla



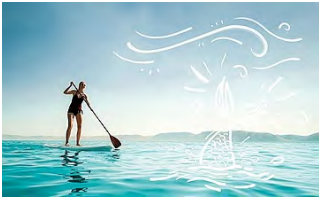
### Sea Trek Helmet Diving in Cozumel

You can snorkel, kayak, paddleboard, take a cooking class, or do a tequila tasting—all of which are included in the tour.
