From Sacsayhuaman you will take a 5-minute van ride to the Q'enco Inca site, which is famous for being home to several Inca Alters. You will not spend as much time here as you did at Sacsayhuaman but enough time to receive a guided tour.

Your next site is another 5-minute drive to Puca Pucara, a small, circular Inca post built as a lookout. The final stop on this tour is Tambomachay, which was built by the Incas as a Water Temple. It has several impressive water fountains, which are thought to have been used by the Incas for bathing. The tour ends with a drive back down to your hotel in Cusco.
