

## Day 4 – August 7<sup>th</sup>: Machu Picchu Tour

Enjoy a relaxed morning and take in the beautiful sights of the surrounding gardens at the Sumaq Hotel. Those who would like to can eat a late breakfast, included at the hotel. At 11:30AM your guide will lead you to the bus stop to take a one-way bus up to the entrance gates of Machu Picchu.

After a few minutes in a security line, you will arrive to the heart of Machu Picchu where you will enjoy a professional, unique guided tour from your tour guide. The formal tour will last 3-4 hours.

**NOTE:** Due to new regulations (effective Jan 1. 2019), the paths that lead through Machu Picchu are all “one-way”, meaning you are not able to backtrack during your visit to Machu Picchu. Each visitor will have ~4 hours to spend inside the park.

### **AFTERNOON/EVENING**

After touring Machu Picchu, you will exit the front gate and walk a few feet to the Belmond Sanctuary Lodge, where you will enjoy an afternoon teatime. After this amazing experience the group will take the buses back to the Aguas Calientes train station where you board the Hiram Bingham train for a first-class trip back to the Poroy Train Station at 6:30 PM.

The group will be picked up from the train station and driven to the Palacio del Inka hotel.
